# What You Need to Know About PROOF OF RESIDENCY

Before any student is assigned or invited to attend a Norwood Public School, the student's parent or legal guardian must prove legal residence in the Town of Norwood. Families whose primary residence is outside of Norwood are NOT eligible to attend Norwood Public Schools. All applicants must submit at least THREE proofs of residency. Documents must be pre-printed with the name and address of the student's parent or guardian and must be presented at the school at the time of registration. These documents also will be required for any change of address.

## A VALID PHOTO I.D. IS REQUIRED AT TIME OF REGISTRATION

In addition, all applicants must submit the following documents from EACH of the following two columns:

### Column A (Need 2 Items)

Copy of deed **AND** record of most recent mortgage payment Copy of lease **AND** record of most recent rent payment Legal affidavit from landlord affirming tenancy **AND** record of most recent rent payment Copy of Section 8 Agreement

### Column B (Need 1 Item)

## Original bill or work order within the past 30 days

(We DO NOT accept cell phone bills or water/sewer bills)

Gas Bill
Oil Bill
Electric Bill
Home Telephone Bill
Cable TV Bill

#### Dated within the past year:

Current vehicle registration Current W-2 form Excise (vehicle) Tax Bill Property Tax Bill

### Dated within the past 60 days:

Letter from approved government agency Bank or credit card statement

If a family is sharing housing with an individual or family, and does not pay rent, the family may submit a letter from the landlord/owner who owns or leases the property.

#### MORE ABOUT RESIDENCY

Legal guardianship requires additional documentation from a court or agency.

This residency policy does **NOT** apply to homeless students.
